- Please note that the 2010 Gold Medal contest will be limited to the first **twenty (20)** competitors whose entries are received by June 30th.
- In the event that only three players enter the Gold Medallist contest, 1st and 2nd place prizes only will be awarded.
- In the event that the winner of the 2010 Gold Medal Contest chooses to play up in the Gold Medallist Contest, they cannot play their winning tune in the Gold Medallist Contest.
- Please note that there will be no MSR contests included in this year's Piobaireachd Society Gold Medal (Canada) Contests.

Competitors will submit **three pairs** from the above list, one of which they will be required to play. Tunes may be played in any order. Prizes will be awarded for performance over the two tunes.

OR

Competitors will submit **six** tunes of their **own choice**, one of which they will be required to play.

- *Settings of these tunes different from those specified will be acceptable provided that the judges are advised in advance and provided with the music for the alternative setting(s) submitted. However, versions of these tunes with conventional taorluath and crunluath movements will not be acceptable. For the purpose of these competitions, only the first line of the urlar need be repeated at the end of each tune and this will be regarded as part of the performance.*
- *Altogether different tunes known by the same or similar names will not be accepted as alternatives.*
- *This list is taken from the Piobaireachd Society Set Tunes for 2010 and is intended to be identical. Any discrepancy between this list and the Piobaireachd Society's is unintentional and as such, competitors should check the Piobaireachd Society's list to ensure that their selections are completely accurate.*

PIOBAIREACHD SOCIETY GOLD MEDAL (CANADA) RULES

Open Piobaireachd for the Piobaireachd Society Gold Medal

Eligibility:

The contest is open to any competitor who has been classified as an Open player and who has never been awarded the Piobaireachd Society Gold Medal in previous contests at any of Ottawa, Cambridge or Maxville, or the Highland Society of London Gold Medal at Inverness or Oban.

Requirements:

Competitors will submit FOUR (4) tunes of their **own choice**, ONE (1) of which they will be required to play.

Gold Medallist for the Piobaireachd Society Bar to the Gold Medal

Eligibility:

Confined to competitors who have previously been awarded the Piobaireachd Society Gold Medal at any of Ottawa, Cambridge or Maxville, or the Highland Society of London Gold Medal at Inverness or Oban.

Requirements:

Competitors will submit **either** THREE (3) pairs from the list of Gold Medallist – Required Tunes as attached, ONE (1) of which they will be required to play, **OR** SIX (6) tunes of their **own choice**, ONE (1) of which they will be required to play.

Note: Settings specified by the list are mandatory and may be obtained from the Hon. Secretary of the Music Committee, 24 Garscube Terrace, Edinburgh, EH12 6BN.

General information about the two Piobaireachd contests:

The Piobaireachd Society Gold Medal CANNOT be won!

The winner of the Piobaireachd Contest will be declared and, in order that no one may gain the medal by default, the Piobaireachd Society Judge will decide if the performance merits the awarding of the medal.

Competitors are not restricted to the settings found in the Piobaireachd Society's Collection or the Kilberry Book or Ceol Mor (except as specified in the note previously). The Judge may, however, take into consideration the merits, authenticity and authority for such settings. Competitors are advised to give ADVANCE notice should they intend to include any settings not contained in either Staff or Editorial Notes in the Piobaireachd Society's Collections. Altogether different tunes, known by the same or similar names, will not be accepted as alternate settings.
